CLASS IV ARTICULATED CRANE (BOOM TRUCK) TRAINING PROGRAM

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Provide Proof of Minimum Grade 10 Education
- Must be a Minimum of 18 Years of Age
- Registration Fee of \$100.00 is Required With Application (Can be in the form of a Money Order, Bank Draft, or Cash. We are unable to accept Personal Cheques.)

COURSE CONTENT:

Our 1 week Class IV Articulated Crane (Boom Truck) training program consists of the following:

- Class IV Articulated Crane Theory & Practical
- Pre-Operating Inspection
- Use of Controls
- Set-up Procedures and Maneuvering Skills
- Basic Lifting Procedures
- Use of Capacity Charts
- Calculating Load Weight
- Material Handling & Rigging Loads

Upon successful completion of program, students will be eligible to write the provincial hoisting examination. If a passing grade is given, 250 hours will be credited toward the 500 hours needed for provincial licensing.

STUDENT TO INSTRUCTOR RATIOS:

At Commercial Safety College, we believe that small class sizes are important to learning a new skill. We ensure that all students get the seat time needed to successfully complete the programs we offer. For our Class IV Articulated Crane training program, our class sizes do not exceed the following:

- Classroom Training – 4 Students to 1 Instructor
- Practical Skills – 4 Students to 1 Instructor
